- >> Those who are unemployed or underemployed including individuals with no work history and those with disabilities, criminal backgrounds, and/or a lack of education.

EMPLOYMENT

In these times of economic uncertainty, the most vulnerable members of the community face unprecedented job loss and financial hardships. The job market has changed, with a decrease in service job positions and expansion of work from home, while our clients face an increasing digital divide and other struggles to enter or re-enter the work force.

Through job coaching and job placement assistance, Goodwill provides employment options for community members who are seeking economic stability.

\$12.26 is the average wage of a placed client, providing a pathway for sustainable employment and a livable wage. (The minimum wage in Texas is \$7.25.)

Donated Goods and Retail's key focus is investing in the success of our 700+ employees through internal advancement, training and servant leadership.

Business Services employs an average of 750 people of which 81% have a significant disability. The average wage is \$16.26, not including benefits, which is a substantial increase from the current Texas minimum wage of \$7.25.
