She loved the job and approached her manager to seek a more permanent position. Melinda was hired to be a photographer for E-Commerce.

Melinda's life skills coach continued to support her and provided resources, including teletherapy sessions to help her address her depression.

Melinda started engaging more with her team and quickly built a circle of friends. She finally had the support system she needed and deserved.
