2023 HIGHLIGHTS



Digital Literacy Program Expanded Into Laredo

Through Goodwill, 36 Laredoans received free basic computer skills training.



New Contracts Awarded to Business Services

Goodwill was awarded 5 federal, state, and city contracts for new grounds maintenance, custodial service, and HVAC filter maintenance, resulting in 84 new jobs.



Goodwill opened 3 stores

Goodwill expanded its retail and donation presence with openings in the Northwest side of San Antonio, the Bulverde and Spring Branch community, and moved its Live Oak store to a larger location, resulting in 59 new jobs.



Goodwill-hosted Career Fairs with Local Employers

Goodwill's 3 career fairs had 50 local employers at each event, offering a starting wage of \$15+/hour to 1,367 job seekers.



DEI-Related Events for Employees

Goodwill's Diversity, Equity, and Inclusion Committee offered trainings and facilitated employee participation in community activities.

Goodwill CEO Appointed to Community Advisory Council.

Goodwill Military Contractor Receives SourceAmerica Award.

SourceAmerica awarded the Air Force Personnel Center at JBSA-Randolph the 2023 Military Customer Award in recognition of its contract with Goodwill San Antonio through the AbilityOne Program. Through its US Air Force Contracts, Goodwill employs 200 individuals of which 88% have a documented disability.



Goodwill Earned Accreditation and Certification for Operational Excellence.

Goodwill achieved the highest level of Commission on Accreditation of Rehabilitation Facilities (CARF) for our tailored processes in workforce development.
